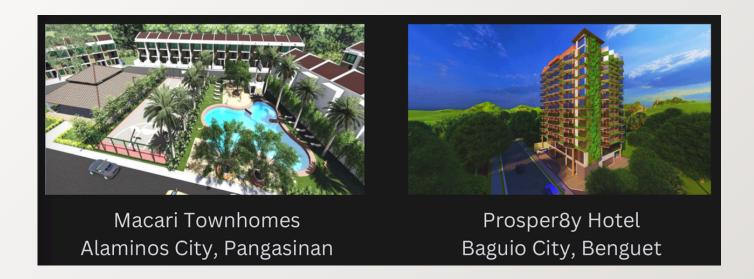

After funding a stagnant development project in the City of Alaminos Pangasinan, K2P was poised to launch the *MaCari Townhomes* in a 2.2 hectares (approx. 5 acres) property as well as the 3-Star *Prosper8y Hotel* in Baguio City as initial residential and hospitality projects in 2022. Another opportunity arose when the Philippine President, H.E. Ferdinand "Bongbong" R. Marcos Jr. launched the *Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino Housing (4PH) Program*, through the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) in December 2022.



Keys 2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation saw the 4PH program as a viable business opportunity that will not only help millions of Filipinos through turnkey development of affordable housing but also as an opportunity to fast-track the excellent track record of the Company by delivering 20,000 quality housing units in various cities and municipalities in the next five years. The K2P Board decided to divert the funding and resources for MaCari Townhomes and Prosper8y Hotel-Baguio towards various 4PH projects in Pangasinan, Bataan, Sorsogon and Samar in coordination with the Local Government Units, the DHSUD and relevant housing agencies.

Keys 2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation is also in the process of investing in relevant construction technology that is better, faster, more affordable and sustainable than what is available in the country today.

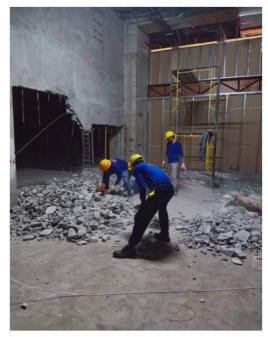


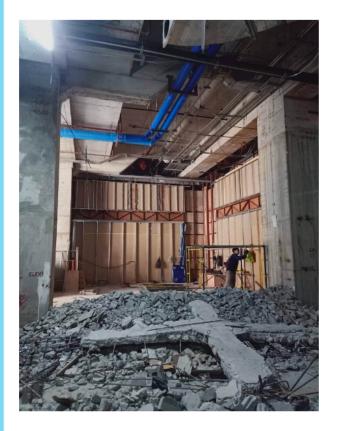

# THE 4PH PROGRAM SUMMARY

The salient points of the Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino Housing Program are:

- 1. The current administration aims to solve the housing shortage by delivering six million affordable housing units until 2028.
- 2. Local Government Units led by the Honorable Mayor shall partner with private contractor /developers such as Keys 2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation to deliver on turnkey modality, housing units as per specified under the 4PH Operations Manual for the beneficiaries indentified by the Local Government Units.
- 3. The Home Mutual Development Fund, or more commonly referred to as the PAG-IBIG Fund, is the funding agency to subsidize the 4PH program.
- 4. The prequalified beneficiaries identified by the Local Government Unit shall receive the housing units from the contractor / developer and LGU upon completion.
- 5. Upon delivery of housing units, the PAG-IBIG Fund shall pay the contractor / developer the value of the property delivered.



# THE 4PH PROGRAM PROCESS

01

The Local Government Unit, led by the Office of the Mayor shall signify their interest to participate in the program through a Letter Of Intent addressed to the DHSUD.

02

After identifying a suitable site for the project, the LGU shall enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with Keys 2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation as the turnkey contractor/developer for the project.

03

The LGU shall identify the number of beneficiaries for the housing project and provide said list to the DHSUD, Contractor/Developer and Pagibig Fund for processing.

04

The LGU, represented by the Mayor shall sign a Tripartite Agreement with DHSUD and Pagibig Fund and the contractor shall construct the housing project to accommodate the number of beneficiaries identified by the LGU.

05

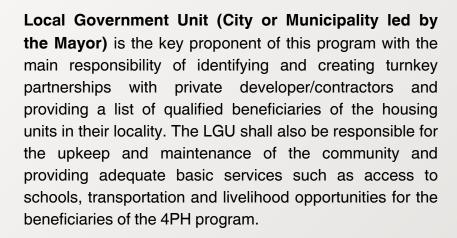
Upon completion of the housing units, the developer/contractor shall submit the individual titles of the completed units to Pagibig and Pagibig shall disburse the payment to the developer/contractor.

#### THE 4PH PROGRAM

# **KEY PROPONENTS**

There are four (4) key proponents in the program:

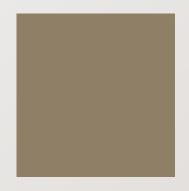
**Development (DHSUD)** is the sole and main planning and policy making, regulatory, program coordination, and performance monitoring entity for all housing, human settlement and urban development concerns primarily focusing on access to and the affordability of basic human needs.



**Keys 2Prosperity Reality Development Corporation (K2P)** is the preferred developer/contractor of the LGU who shall be tasked with the identification and acquisition of land, planning and initial funding of the project, development and construction, among other responsibilities in the 4PH program.

Home Mutual Development Fund (Pag-IBIG Fund) is a Government owned and controlled Corporation (GOCC) established in 1978 as a National Savings Program for the Filipinos that later evolved mainly as a housing loan facility for its mandatory members. All workers in the Philippines are required to become Pag-IBIG members with mandatory contribution of between 1% to 3% of their base salaries. Private and public employers are directed to automatically deduct the mandatory contributions from tha salaries for direct remittance to the Pag-IBIG Fund. The fund collects more than 4 Billion Pesos monthly from its 15 million members.







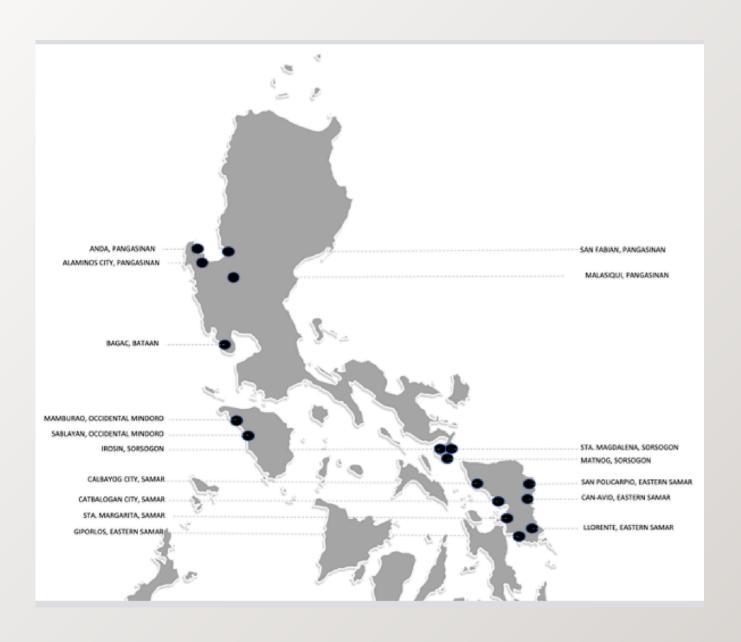

With the refocus to the 4PH program and diversion of funding and resources to the 4PH projects, Keys 2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation has coordinated with the Local Government Units and the DHSUD to deliver 20,000 affordable housing units in five years.

Letters of Intent has been signed and delivered by several Local Government Units, properties identified and project planning is underway for seven of the targeted eighteen 4PH projects nationwide with a total value of around *Thirty (30) Billion Pesos*.

# **ALAMINOS CITY**

**Alaminos City** in the Province of Pangasinan in Northern Luzon is known for being the home of the Hundred Islands National Park, composed of 124 islands and located off the coast of the Alaminos City proper. As of 2020, the city has a population of 99,937 people that balloons to more than 500,000 during peak tourist seasons. The Alaminos City airport is planned to be built within the city as a commercial airport for the province.

Keys 2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation owns a parcel of land with an area of 22,011 square meters along Bainto Road, Barangay Bolaney, Alaminos City, Pangasinan. Originally planned as townhouse development called MaCari Townhomes, the project was diverted into a 4PH project to benefit the 900 plus beneficiaries as identified by the Alaminos City government.

**ALAMINOS PROSPERITY RESIDENCES** will be the first 4PH project of K2P to break ground, with;

- the Letter of Intent and City Council Resolution signed and delivered,
- · Project plans submitted and approved by the DHSUD,
- Memorandum of Agreement (*Bipartite Agreement*) between the City of Alaminos and Keys 2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation, signed and duly notarized,
- Memorandum of Agreement (*Tripartite Agreement*) between the DHSUD, Pag-IBIG and Alaminos City LGU, signed and notarized.

WHEREAS, Keys2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation, a private developer and a key shelter agency, signified its willingness to participate in the Program by financing the LGU-Alaminos City's identified housing project's land development and housing construction component;

WHEREAS, LGU-Alaminos City and Keys2Prosperity Realty Development Corporation expressed their willingness to complement each other and jointly pursue the objectives of the 4PH Program;

WHEREAS, to ensure smooth implementation of the Program in the city, there is a need for the parties to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 86 (vi) of the IRR of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinances;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon due deliberation on the merits surrounding the issue and on motion of Councilor Joselito O. Fontelera, duly seconded by all members present, it was;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to authorize City Mayor Arth Bryan C. CELESTE, by virtue of City Resolution No. 2023-159¹, dated July 25, 2023, hereinafter referred to as the "LGU".

KEYS2 PROSPERITY REALTY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at Suite 503 OMM-Citra Building, San Miguel Avenue, Ortigas Center, Pasig City, represented herein by its President, MR. ERWIN M. DE GUZMAN, by virtue of the Board Resolution, verified through a Secretary's Certificate<sup>2</sup>, and hereinafter referred to as the "DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR".

#### WITNESSETH

THE NAME OF THE PERSON OF THE

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) launched its flagship program in the year 2022: "Pambansang Pabahay Para Sa Pilipino: Zero ISF Program for 2028";

WHEREAS, Department Circular No. 2022-04 dated December 15, 2022, declared the Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino (4PH) Program as a priority program of DHSUD;

WHEREAS, the 4PH Program is a government housing program implemented by the DHSUD in partnership with its key shelter agencies, which aims to address the country's housing needs of over six million (6,000,000.00) by 2028;

WHEREAS, by virtue of City Resolution No. 2023-159, the City Mayor was authorized to sign this Memorandum of Agreement with the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR as entity to construct and develop the socialized housing project in connection with the implementation of the 4PH Program herewith;

WHEREAS, the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR, along with their affiliates, have signified their willingness to participate in the Program by financing the LGU's identified Housing Project's (the "PROJECT") land development and housing construction component through direct developmental loans from Key Shelter Agencies (KSAs) and/or Government Financial Institutions (GFIs);



WHEREAS, pursuant to the guidelines for the implementation of the 4PH Program (Operations Manual), the developer/s may participate in the 4PH program under a turnkey arrangement where the developer may either assume the responsibility of land acquisition, site development, and housing construction, subject to applicable guidelines of the LGU;

Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino Housing (4PH) Program

WHEREAS, the LGU and DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR have expressed their willingness to complement each other and jointly pursue the objectives of the 4PH Program, whereby the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR shall provide the necessary land acquisition, site development, and housing construction for the PROJECT while the LGU shall provide the list of qualified beneficiaries who will purchase the housing units and implement the PROJECT for its own target beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, the PARTIES hereto commit to faithfully perform their obligations as contained herein by providing quality yet affordable shelters to the underprivileged beneficiaries as one of the main thrusts of our government. Through competence and active involvement, this undertaking or project is in pursuit of sustainable solutions for the growing housing backlogs in the City Government Alaminos, Pangasinan.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Parties have agreed as follows:

# SECTION 1 DEFINITION OF TERMS DEFINITION OF TERMS AND INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 Definition of Terms. As used herein, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
  - a. CLEAN TITLE shall refer to a parcel of land that is registered in the name of the developer/contractor and is entirely free of any lien or encumbrance.
  - b. NEAR-CLEAN TITLE shall refer to a parcel of land that is affected by a lien or encumbrance (including any adverse claim or interest) or any issue, complication, or obstacle that can be resolved within the timeframe needed for its utilization and the completion of the PROJECT.
  - c. CONTRACTOR refers to any person who undertakes or offers to undertake the construction, repair, or improvement of any building, structure, or project, or who provides labor and materials for the completion of an identified project under the specified engagement terms or contract.
  - d. DEVELOPER shall refer to any natural or juridical person engaged in the business of real estate development for his/her or its own account and offering them for sale or lease, duly authorized, selected, and/or partnered with by the LGU. For purposes of Pag-IBIG's Direct Developmental Loan Program, a developer must have an established track record of at least five (5) years in housing development and at least three hundred (300) completed house and lot / condominium units to be able to avail of the Developmental Loan from Pag-IBIG FUND.
  - e. DEVELOPMENTAL LOAN refers to the financial loan to be extended by the Pag-IBIG FUND to the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR for the development and completion of the PROJECT.
  - MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) shall refer to this agreement, including all future amendments and supplements thereto.
  - g. PROJECT shall mean the medium/high-rise condominium building projects that will be developed by the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR, with all the necessary utility systems and support facilities such as roads, power, drainage, and water distribution.

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- h. PROJECT BENEFICIARIES shall refer to individuals with designated income levels to whom specific areas of the PROJECT as developed and completed will be sold, who shall be identified and selected by the LGU, with eligibility for loans under the Pag-IBIG FUND's prevailing housing loan policies and guidelines for the 4PH program.
- i. TURNKEY shall refer to the implementation modality of the 4PH Program whereby the private developer assumes the responsibility of land acquisition, site development, and/or housing construction. The completed housing project shall be turned over/sold to the 4PH project beneficiaries in coordination with the LGU. For this purpose, there is a complete turn-key arrangement when the private developer fully assumes responsibility over the land acquisition, the site development, and the housing construction.

#### 1.2 Interpretation

The headings and subheadings in this Memorandum of Agreement are inserted for convenience of reference only and shall not limit or affect the interpretation of the provisions hereof. Unless the context otherwise requires, words denoting the singular number shall include the plural, and vice versa. References to Sections and Exhibits are to be construed as references to the sections and exhibits of and to this Memorandum of Agreement while references to Annexes are to be deemed references to the implementing documents, consisting of the Loan Agreement and the Deed of Assignment of Take-Out/ Sales Proceeds and other income/revenues, annexed hereto and made an integral part hereof.



#### SECTION 2 PRINCIPAL CONSIDERATIONS

#### 2.1 Principal Considerations

The **PARTIES** hereto accept and recognize that the principal object of this Memorandum of Agreement is the implementation and completion of the PROJECT under the 4PH Program of **DHSUD** for the benefit of the Project Beneficiaries as herein described and defined.

#### 2.2 Project Implementation

The LGU, as the lead implementer of this PROJECT, shall ensure that the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR qualifies or meets the eligibility or criteria for condominium developments, equipped with capabilities, skills, expertise, and with a proven track record.

Forging this agreement with the **DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR** and setting clearly the specific responsibilities and other governing provisions for the project implementation in a separate agreement, this 4PH PROJECT shall be developed by the **DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR**, who possesses the skill, expertise, and capability to undertake the construction of the intended PROJECT.



To finance the implementation of the PROJECT, the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR may avail of Developmental Loan provided by the Pag-IBIG FUND for site development and condominium construction under the terms and conditions hereinafter stated. The DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR shall provide for the parcel of land that may be used as collateral security in availing of a direct developmental loan from the Pag-IBIG FUND.

#### Permits/Clearances

All PARTIES, within their capacities, shall cooperate and complement each other in securing the necessary permits and clearances necessary for the implementation of this PROJECT.

The DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR commits to comply with the documentary requirements of Pag-IBIG developmental loan program, including the permits/clearances as provided on the Pag-IBIG standard Checklist of Requirements, in the event that they opt to secure a developmental loan from Pag-IBIG FUND.

#### Market

# SECTION 4 RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS

- 4.1 Responsibilities and Obligations of the LGU. The LGU shall:
  - 4.1.1 Identify, select, and facilitate the application of target housing beneficiaries under the 4PH program. It shall set the eligibility criteria for, and identify the project beneficiaries. It shall carry out the beneficiary listing, which shall include, but not be limited to, social preparations, ISF census enumeration, socio-economic profiling, and the establishment of social parameters.
  - 4.1.2 Provide the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR the list of legitimate and qualified beneficiaries who are entitled to purchase, reside in, and occupy the housing units of the PROJECT;
  - 4.1.3 Promote to the beneficiaries the housing loan programs of Pag-IBIG FUND and assist the beneficiaries in their applications for Pag-IBIG Fund Housing Loans through orientation of the guidelines and loan requirements of Pag-IBIG FUND;
  - 4.1.4 Conduct social preparation of target beneficiaries in coordination with DHSUD and its KSAs, i.e., socio-economic survey, Information and Educational Campaigns, etc.;
  - 4.1.5 Facilitate the expeditious issuance of local permits and clearances for the PROJECT; and
  - 4.1.6 It shall immediately and readily replace delinquent beneficiaries who were not able to pay their respective loan installments as they fell due.
  - Responsibilities and Obligations of the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR. The DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR shall have the following obligations:
    - 4.2.1 Land Ownership. It has a clean title over the parcel of land subject of this Agreement as defined in Section 3.1;
    - 4.2.2 It shall cause and ensure that the land title of the land where the Project is located is free from all liens, claims, or encumbrances, and that the land is free and unoccupied by any settlers upon or at the commencement of the land development and housing construction. The contractor shall secure release instruments for any annotation that may be found on the subject TCTs;
    - 4.2.3 Land Development, and Housing Construction. It shall finance the land acquisition, land development, and housing with the approved detailed costing/bill of materials, labor and other indirect costs for the Projects within the parameters set by DHSUD. It shall include the construction of roads, drainage, and open space facilities, as well as any taxes, fees, and charges that may be assessed on the project, except upon waiver or exemption granted by the LGU;
    - 4.2.4 In financing the land and housing development of the Project, it may secure a developmental loan from the Pag-IBIG FUND (or other GFIs enrolled in the Program) in a manner consistent with the standards of DHSUD under the 4PH Program and other concerned regulatory agencies;

- 4.2.5 Documentation. DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR undertakes and ensures that it has the capacity to handle, manage and process Contract to Sell (CTS) with qualified beneficiaries for takeout and conversion of the same to Real Estate Mortgage with Pag-IBIG FUND;
- 4.2.6 It shall account for the applicable local transfer taxes and registration fees covering the Land including its housing component/improvement and shall account for the real property taxes due thereon, as applicable; and,
- 4.2.7 It shall be responsible for the management of the estate unless otherwise transferred/turned over to the LGU, the Registered Homeowners Association, or Condominium Association/Corporation, as may be applicable.

# SECTION 5 REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

- 5.1 Representations and Warranties of the LGU. The LGU hereby represents and warrants that:
  - 5.1.1 It has the full power, authority, and legal right to enter into this Agreement, to exercise its rights and perform its obligations hereunder, and to consummate the transactions contemplated herein;
  - 5.1.2 It shall comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations, issuances, and orders of relevant government agencies in the performance of its obligations under this Agreement and the Deed/s, including any future construction or development activities therein;
  - 5.1.3 All consents necessary for the due execution, delivery, and performance of this Agreement and the Deed/s have been obtained;
  - 5.1.4 It shall limit the allowable activities to be conducted on the land and within the Project to residential, small and medium-sized enterprises, and other related activities, and shall prohibit activities that have the potential to cause or may actually cause any form of disturbance or nuisance to the Project and its Beneficiaries;
  - 5.1.5 It shall assist and provide the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR easy processing of the necessary permits, licenses, certificates, and/or approvals in relation to the development of the Project;
- 5.2 Representations and Warranties of the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR. The DEVELOPER/ CONTRACTOR hereby represents and warrants that:
  - 5.2.1 It is a duly organized corporation, validly existing, and in good standing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines;
  - 5.2.2 It has full power, authority, and legal right to enter into this Agreement, to exercise its rights and perform its obligations hereunder, and to consummate the transaction contemplated herein;
  - 5.2.3 It warrants for one (1) year from the completion of the PROJECT any defects in the land development and housing construction;

- 5.2.4 The development plans for the PROJECT have been approved by applicable regulatory agencies and other concerned parties;
- 5.2.5 The DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR shall ensure that their proposed housing structure and design, along with the price ceiling, conform to the standard parameters set by DHSUD and shall secure necessary permits, clearances, registration, and licenses to sell from corresponding local offices and government agencies;
- 5.2.6 All consents necessary for the due execution, delivery, and performance of this Agreement have been obtained;
- 5.2.7 It shall hold the LGU, including their officials and personnel, free and harmless from any and all claims, actions, liabilities, losses, and suits which may be brought or instituted by any party whatsoever by reason of the fault, failure, negligence, delay, or any conduct of the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR, its respective officers, employees, and agents in the performance of their corresponding obligation under this Agreement, without prejudice to its claim against the proper erring party;
- 5.2.8 The obligations expressed to be assumed by it under this Agreement are legal, valid, and binding obligations, enforceable against them in accordance with the terms and conditions hereof, and that all acts, conditions, and things required by their Articles of Incorporation to be done, fulfilled, or performed in order to enable it to enter into, execute, deliver, exercise its rights, and perform its obligations hereunder are within its power to perform as provided under its Articles of Incorporation; and
- 5.2.9 It shall cause and ensure the completion of the housing project, which includes land development and housing construction, in accordance with existing government-prescribed laws and standards, along with the minimum standards for the design and proposed price ceiling parameters set by DHSUD, for projects to be accredited under the 4H Program.

# Section 6 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Complete Agreement. This Agreement contains the full and complete agreement among the Parties on the subject matter, and the same shall supersede any and all representations, understandings, or agreements, verbal or written, implied or express, previously made or entered into by them. This MOA may only be amended upon the written mutual agreement of the Parties.

It is understood that all terms and conditions herein provided are subject to and subordinate to the existing laws, rules, and regulations of the **LGU**. In case of conflict, the pertinent provisions of the law, rules, and regulations shall prevail.

- 6.2 Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed simultaneously in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
  - 3 Good Faith. In complying with and implementing the terms of this Agreement, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to ensure the fulfillment of their common objective of providing adequate, livable, affordable, and inclusive housing and communities to the Filipinos.

- 6.4 Binding Effect. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the Parties hereto and their respective successors-in-interest and assigns.
- 6.5 Non-Waiver of Rights. The failure of a Party to insist upon a strict performance of any of the terms, conditions, and covenants under this Agreement shall not be deemed a relinquishment or waiver of any right/remedy that the aforesaid Party may have, nor shall it be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or other terms, conditions, and covenants. Any waiver, extension, or forbearance of any of the terms, conditions, and covenants of this Agreement by any Party shall be in writing and limited to the particular instance only and shall not in any manner whatsoever be construed as a waiver, extension, or forbearance of any other term, condition, and/or covenant of this Agreement.
- 6.6 Force Majeure. No Party shall be liable for any failure or delay in the performance of its respective obligations as herein provided if any force majeure event shall be the proximate cause of the same.

For purposes of this Agreement, a "Force Majeure Event" shall include, but not be limited to: (i) declared or undeclared war, armed hostilities, revolution, rebellion, insurrection, riot, public disorder, and the like; (ii) unforeseen rock formations in the geodetic layers of the identified deep well sites; and (iii) extreme and unforeseen weather conditions, fire, unusual flood, earthquake, and similar calamities or acts of God, and Government's, local or national, declaration of community quarantines and other restrictions; and (iv) expropriation on any part of the site on which the Project will be located.



The Party invoking the existence of a Force Majeure Event shall immediately notify the other Party, specifying the nature and details of the Force Majeure Event, how it affects the Party's ability to comply with its obligations hereunder, and a proposed mitigating action to address the same. Upon the cessation of such Force Majeure Event, the Parties shall immediately resume the performance of their obligations hereunder.

However, if the Force Majeure Event extends for a period in excess of 180 continuous days, the Parties hereto shall meet to discuss the basis and terms upon which this Agreement be continued or mutually terminated.



Amendments. Any amendment or additional term and condition to this Agreement must be in writing. The parties hereto may, at any time, by mutual agreement, execute a supplement or amendment for the purpose of adding provisions to or changing or eliminating provisions of this Memorandum of Agreement.

Dispute Resolution. Any conflict or dispute that may arise out of this Agreement on the interpretation or implementation of any provision hereof shall be settled amicably within thirty (30) days, through the authorized representatives of the Parties. Either Party may initiate amicable discussions by sending written notice to the other Party, specifying the alleged dispute and proposing a schedule for the amicable settlement thereof.



Separability. If any part of this Memorandum of Agreement shall for any reason be declared invalid and unenforceable, the remaining portions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect as if this Memorandum of Agreement was executed with such invalid portion eliminated, or as if the parties would not have executed this Memorandum of Agreement had they known the invalidity or unenforceability thereof.

This Memorandum of Agreement (the "MOA") is made, entered into, and executed this **JAN 0 9 2024** by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SETTLEMENTS AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT**, a national government agency primarily responsible for management of housing, human settlement, and urban development, with office address at the DHSUD Building, Kalayaan Avenue corner Mayaman Street, Diliman, Quezon City, herein represented by UNDERSECRETARY EMMANUEL D. PINEDA, by virtue of Special Order No. 2023-447, Series of 2023, hereinafter referred to as "DHSUD";

The HOME DEVELOPMENT MUTUAL FUND (also known as Pag-IBIG FUND), a government financial institution duly organized and existing under and by virtue of Republic Act No. 9679, with principal office at Petron MegaPlaza, 358 Sen. Gil Puyat Avenue, Makati City, represented in this Act by its CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER MARILENE C. ACOSTA, hereinafter referred to as the "Pag-IBIG FUND";

The CITY GOVERNMENT OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN, a Local Government Unit existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office at Quezon Avenue, Brgy. Poblacion, Alaminos City, Pangasinan 2404, represented by its City Mayor, ARTH BRYAN C. CELESTE, duly authorized under Sanggunian Panlungsod Resolution No.2023-1601, dated July 25, 2023, and hereinafter referred to as the "LGU"

The DHSUD, Pag-IBIG FUND, and the LGU may also be individually referred to as "Party," and collectively as "Parties."

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11201 created the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) as the primary national government entity responsible for policy, direction, regulation, and management of housing, human settlements, and urban development;

WHEREAS, the Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development (DHSUD) launched its flagship program in the year 2022: "Pambansang Pabahay Para Sa Pilipino: Zero ISF Program for 2028";

WHEREAS, Department Circular No. 2022-04 dated December 15, 2022, declared the Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino (4PH) Program as a priority program of DHSUD;

WHEREAS, the Pambansang Pabahay Para sa Pilipino (4PH) Program is a government housing program implemented by the DHSUD in partnership with its key shelter agencies, which aims to address the country's housing needs of over six million (6,000,000.00) by 2028;

WHEREAS, Pag-IBIG FUND is one of the premier financial institutions in the country, which aims to establish, develop, promote, and integrate a nationwide mutual provident savings system suitable for the needs of the employed and other earning groups, motivate, better plan, and provide for their housing needs by becoming qualified members of Pag-IBIG FUND with mandatory contributory support of employers in the spirit of social justice and the pursuit of national development;

WHEREAS, pursuant to and in accordance with its mandate, the Pag-IBIG FUND implemented the Direct Developmental Loan Program which aims to increase the number of end-user availments by providing additional housing inventories through developmental financing;

WHEREAS, in support to the 4PH Program, Pag-IBIG FUND as one of Government Financial Institutions (GFIs), has made its funds available for the development of housing projects under the program through its Pag-IBIG FUND Direct Developmental Loan Program;

WHEREAS, the LGU, pursuant to its agreement with the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR, has adopted the implementation of the 4PH program;

WHEREAS, the LGU shall be the lead proponent for the Project, the DHSUD shall oversee the implementation and other compliances necessary for the project, and the Pag-IBIG FUND shall fund the project as needed;

WHEREAS, the PARTIES have expressed their willingness to complement each other and jointly help to pursue the Program and commit to faithfully perform their obligations as contained herein, providing quality yet affordable shelter to the underprivileged beneficiaries being one of the main thrusts of our government. Through competence and active involvement, this undertaking or project is in pursuit of sustainable solutions for the growing housing backlogs in the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan.

**NOW THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Parties hereby agree and bind themselves to the following

# SECTION 1 DEFINITION OF TERMS AND INTERPRETATION

#### Section 1.1. Definition of Terms

As used herein, the following terms shall have the following meanings:

- (a) CONTRACTOR refers to any person who undertakes or offers to undertake the construction, repair, improvement of any building, structure, or project, or who provides labor and materials for the completion of an identified project under the specified engagement terms or contract;
- (b) DEVELOPER shall refer to any natural or juridical person engaged in the business of real estate development for his/her or its own account and offering them for sale or lease, duly authorized, selected, and/or partnered with by the LGU. For purposes of Pag-IBIG's Direct Developmental Loan Program (DDLP), a DEVELOPER must have an established track record of at least five (5) years in housing development and with at least three hundred (300) completed house and lot / condominium units to be able to avail of the Developmental Loan from Pag-IBIG FUND;
- (c) DEVELOPMENTAL LOAN refers to the financial loan to be extended by Pag-IBIG FUND to the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR for the development and completion of the PROJECT in accordance with the former's guidelines for the 4PH DDLP and the amendments thereof;
- (c) END-USER FINANCING shall refer to a housing loan program or package to be extended by the Pag-IBIG FUND to the qualified target project beneficiaries of the housing PROJECT;
- (d) INFORMAL SETTLER FAMILIES (ISFs) refers to the primary target beneficiaries of the PROJECT that are living under challenged conditions residing in blighted areas, waterways, and other danger zones, as determined and verified by the LGU;
- (e) MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT shall mean this agreement, including all future amendments and supplements thereto;
- (f) PROJECT shall mean the multi- level condominium projects, pursuant to the 4PH Program, that will be developed by the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR, with all the necessary utility systems such as roads, power, drainage and water distribution;
  - PROJECT BENEFICIARIES shall refer to the individuals with designated income levels, to whom specific areas of the PROJECT as developed and completed will be sold, and who shall be identified and selected by the LGU, with eligibility for loans under the Pag-IBIG FUND's prevailing housing loan policies and guidelines for 4PH program; and

- (h) NECESSARY SUPPORT FACILITIES shall include, but is not limited to, concrete roads, drainage system, water and power connections; and
- (i) TURNKEY shall refer to the implementation modality of the 4PH Program whereby the private developer assumes the responsibility of land acquisition, site development, and/or housing construction. The completed housing project shall be turned over/sold to the 4PH project beneficiaries in coordination with the LGU. For this purpose, there is a complete turn-key arrangement when the private developer fully assumes responsibility over the land acquisition, the site development, and the housing construction.

Section 1.2 Interpretation. The headings in this Memorandum of Agreement are inserted for convenience of reference only and shall not limit or affect the interpretation of the provisions hereof. Unless the context otherwise requires, words denoting the singular number shall include the plural, and vice versa. References to Sections and Exhibits are to be construed as references to the Sections and exhibits of and to this Memorandum of Agreement while references to Annexes are to be deemed references to the implementing documents, consisting of the Loan Agreement and the Deed of Assignment of Take-out/ Sales Proceeds and other income/revenues, annexed hereto and made an integral part hereof.

# SECTION 4 RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

#### Section 4.1. RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF DHSUD

- 4.1.1 DHSUD shall facilitate, either directly or through its Key Shelter Agencies (KSAs), the implementation of the housing projects in collaboration with the LGU and other relevant agencies by acting as the overall enabler, initiator, coordinator, and facilitator of the Housing Program;
- 4.1.2 It shall facilitate the provision of funds for the program through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for use as interest subsidy for the program's project beneficiaries;
- 4.1.3 The 4PH beneficiaries will be entitled to an interest subsidy not to exceed five percent (5%). Corollary, the 4PH beneficiaries shall pay minimum interest rate of one percent (1%).
- 4.1.4 The interest subsidy shall be sourced from the Annual Appropriations Act or from any other sources of funds to be provided by the National Government. It may also be derived from any future legislation that Congress may pass in relation to the program;
- 4.1.5 It shall assist in the reduction and simplification of qualification and accreditation requirements for the participating **DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR**;
- 4.1.6 As initiator, coordinator, and overall enabler, it shall oversee and monitor the implementation of the 4PH Program, including the project implementation and performance of all PARTIES;
- 4.1.7 It shall also assist the **LGU** in obtaining the necessary permits and licenses from national government agencies;
- 4.1.8 It warrants expediting the development of the housing projects enrolled in or registered with the 4PH Program. In this regard, it shall assist in providing the performance parameters and specifications, support, and technical assistance to the LGU, and other program partners, including the facilitation of the License-to-Sell (LS) and other requirements needed for the issuance of a Development Permit (DP);
- 4.1.9 It shall coordinate with the LGU for the list of qualified beneficiaries entitled to housing units in the PROJECT;
- 4.1.10 It shall assist in the organization of homeowner's association among the buyers and residents; and
- 4.1.11 It may extend necessary support and assistance within its powers and capacity in order to implement the **PROJECT**.

#### Section 4.2. RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PAG-IBIG FUND

- 4.2.1 It shall extend Direct Developmental Loan to the DEVELOPER/ CONTRACTOR, who passed the accreditation process, in the event that the latter chose to avail of the same, in accordance with Pag-IBIG FUND's existing wholesale loan policies and guidelines for the land development and construction of the proposed housing project;
- 4.2.2 It may provide technical assistance to the LGU including, but not limited to, the project conceptualization and packaging to facilitate the full implementation of the PROJECT;
- 4.2.3 It shall extend individual housing loans to eligible beneficiaries prequalified and selected by the LGU, pursuant to the socialized housing price ceiling jointly determined by DHSUD and NEDA, and subject further to Pag-IBIG FUND's prevailing housing loan policies and guidelines for the 4PH program;
- 4.2.4 It shall provide housing loan counseling;
- 4.2.5 It may assist the **LGU** in coordinating with other Key Shelter Agencies for the successful implementation of the housing project; and
- 4.2.6 It shall simplify the guidelines and requirements to facilitate the access to financing by the LGU, if needed, its authorized developers/contractors, and homebuyer-beneficiaries.

#### Section 4.3. RESPONSIBILITIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE LGU

- 4.3.1 It shall cause its partner **DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR** to ensure that the land title of the **DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR** where the **PROJECT** will be located is free from all liens, claims, or encumbrances, and that the land is free and unoccupied by any settlers upon or at the commencement of the land development and housing construction. The **DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR** shall likewise ensure that the land is physically suitable and accessible for the **PROJECT**:
- 4.3.2 It shall hold Pag-IBIG FUND, its member-borrowers, successors-in-interest, assigns, and its employees, officers harmless from and against all losses, costs, liabilities, claims, damages and expenses of every kind and character, resulting from or relating to or arising out of any dispute or claim on the control and rightful possessor of the land and validity of the land title;
- 4.3.3 It shall ensure that the project design pertaining to the type of land development, structural designs, and condominium units, and other specifications to be proposed by the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR conform to the applicable DHSUD standards, and other relevant or applicable laws, rules and regulations;

- 4.3.4 It shall assist and provide easy processing of the necessary permits, licenses, certificates, and/or approvals in relation to the development of the PROJECT:
- 4.3.5 It may provide support to the PROJECT and its beneficiaries, either through monthly amortization support and/or other commitments and assistance, such as additional land donation and site development, to make the units affordable to target project beneficiaries;
- It shall identify qualified project beneficiaries based on the eligibility requirements provided by the Pag-IBIG FUND's prevailing housing loan policies and guidelines for the 4PH Program and existing laws, rules and regulations;
- 4.3.7 It shall submit to DHSUD and the Pag-IBIG FUND list of the legitimate and qualified beneficiaries who are entitled to reside and occupy the housing units of the PROJECT;
- It shall promote to the beneficiaries the housing loan programs of Pag-4.3.8 IBIG FUND and assist the beneficiaries in their application for Pag-IBIG FUND Housing Loans through an orientation of the guidelines and loan requirements of Pag-IBIG Fund;
- 4.3.9 It shall ensure that the necessary facilities are in place, such as, but not limited to, a concrete road, a drainage system, water supply, and power connections. It shall ensure that the necessary facilities are available upon occupancy by the LGU's beneficiaries on the PROJECT;
- 4.3.10 It shall ensure for the estate/property management of the project and the availability of funds for the purpose;
- 4.3.11 It shall formulate local policies and programs to support and facilitate project financing, construction, and property management, including necessary financial and social services assistance for the target beneficiaries;
- 4.3.12 It shall ensure that the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR complies with the technical, financial, and documentary requirements as may be required under the 4PH Program;
- 4.3.13 It shall perform any and all actions, obligations, or responsibilities that the LGU may wish to undertake for the proper and full implementation of the Program, provided that it is not contrary to law, good custom, public order, or public policy, and its executed MOA;
- 4.3.14 It shall oversee the completion of the PROJECT within the construction schedule and extensions, if any, as approved by DHSUD.
- 4.3.15 It shall ensure that the Master Deed for the PROJECT, or any other document relative to the administration of the project, does not contain limitation/s and restriction/s that will affect the right of Pag-IBIG FUND

to enforce its rights, interests or lien on the property, to recover on its exposure by subsequent sale of the collateral to the individual housing loan that has become its acquired assets, and ensure that the property subject of the individual housing loans provided to the project beneficiaries is not impaired.

#### SECTION 5 WARRANTY AND SECURITY

Section 5.1. The loan shall be secured by any or all of the following:

Real Estate Mortgage on the real estate property subject of the loan including the land and/or building/improvements comprising the housing project and any improvements that will thereafter exist on the project site.

In the event that the value of the on-site collateral is insufficient, the loan may be secured by additional or off-site collateral acceptable to the Pag-IBIG FUND. This may come in the form of undeveloped, partially developed, or developed residential lands, either adjacent or contiguous to the PROJECT/S site or located in another area, or in any other form as maybe allowed under the Pag-IBIG Fund's prevailing guidelines.

Section 5.2. Assignment of Takeout Proceeds and/or Sales Income

The LGU shall ensure that the **DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR** shall be allowed to assign to the Pag-IBIG FUND the loan proceeds of accounts that have been financed through the prevailing Pag-IBIG End-User Home Financing Program and/or the income from sales of the PROJECT to be financed, thereby authorizing the Pag-IBIG FUND to apply the said amount to the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR's outstanding obligation.

#### SECTION 6 **MISCELLANEOUS**

Section 6.1. Complete Agreement. This Agreement shall be construed as a general agreement on commitments between the Parties. The same shall supersede any and all representations, understandings, or agreements, verbal or written, implied or express, previously made or entered into by them. It is understood that all terms and conditions herein provided are subject to and subordinate to the existing laws, rules, and regulations. In case of conflict, the pertinent provisions of the law, rules, and regulations shall prevail;

Section 6.2. Effectivity. This Agreement shall take effect upon its execution and shall remain effective, unless otherwise terminated through written and mutual agreement by the Parties or upon satisfaction of the objectives by which this Agreement was forged.

Section 6.3. Non-waiver of Rights. The failure of a Party to insist upon a strict performance of any of the terms, conditions, and covenants under this Agreement shall not be deemed a relinquishment or waiver of any right/remedy that the aforesaid Party may have, nor shall it be construed as a waiver of any subsequent breach of the same or other terms, conditions, and covenants. Any waiver, extension, or forbearance of any of the terms, conditions, and covenants of this Agreement by any Party shall be in writing and limited to the particular instance only and shall not in any manner whatsoever be

construed as a waiver, extension, or forbearance of any other term, condition, and/or covenant of this Agreement.

Section 6.4. Amendments. Any amendment or additional term and condition to this Agreement must be in writing. The parties hereto may, at any time, by mutual agreement, execute a supplement or amendment for the purpose of adding provisions to or changing or eliminating provisions of this Memorandum of Agreement.

To ensure compliance with the prevailing guidelines and business rules of the Pag-IBIG FUND relative to the grant of the developmental loan or other funding facility, the parties shall execute a supplemental or amendatory agreement, upon demand from the Pag-IBIG FUND.

Nothing in this Memorandum of Agreement shall preclude the parties from entering into a separate agreement, as they may deem necessary, in furtherance of the objectives and for the implementation of the intended housing PROJECT/S.

Section 6.5. Assignment and Sub-Contracting. Unless otherwise stated in this Agreement, a party shall not assign or transfer any of its interests and title under this Agreement nor subcontract any portion of the work covered by the contract without the written consent of the other party.

Section 6.6. Additional Developmental Loan. The DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR new developmental loan; provided, DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR meets the criteria for a new loan. The total debt shall be evaluated at any given time and must not exceed the Single Borrower's Limit.

Section 6.7. Cross Default. A default in one developmental loan with Pag-IBIG FUND shall entail a default in the other direct developmental loans with Pag-IBIG FUND.

Section 6.8. Governing Law and Venue of Suit. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed according to the laws of the Republic of the Philippines. The venue of any court action with respect to this Agreement shall be the proper court of Quezon City only, to the exclusion of any other venues.

Section 6.9. Counterparts. This MOA may be executed simultaneously in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

Section 6.10. Good Faith. In complying with and implementing the terms of this MOA, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to ensure the fulfillment of their common objective.

Section 6.11. Successors and Assigns. This MOA shall inure to the benefit of the PARTIES hereto and their respective successors and assigns, except that the LGU shall ensure that the DEVELOPER/CONTRACTOR cannot transfer and/or assign its rights and obligations hereunder to a third party without the written conformity of the Pag-IBIG FUND.

**Section 6.12. 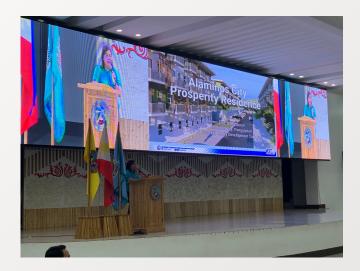


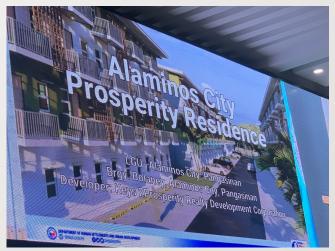
